From the Tee Box...

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion
March 15th and 16th, 2008

And when he entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" And the crowds replied, "This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee." (Mark 21:11)



Dear Friends:

This weekend we formally begin the celebration of Holy Week with Palm Sunday. The church refers to these days as *"the holiest week of the year."* As we will hear in the Prayer of the Blessing of Palms, *"we enter, with Christ, into his suffering and death."* The story of these last moments in the life of Jesus are celebrated in a very unique way in our Catholic tradition. We recall the moments from cross to death to resurrection, but we continue to celebrate the real and true presence of Jesus in our lives and in eucharist. I strongly encourage you to join us for our Holy Week liturgies. Each day brings with it a different part of the story:

Holy Thursday Celebration of the Lord's Supper: on this night we celebrate 3 wonderful gifts in our lives and the life of the church. We celebrate the institution of the eucharist, the institution of the priesthood, and our call to service of one another. We begin this liturgy on a high note, experience the re-enactment of the washing of the feet of the 12 apostles, and make the transition to reverent and complete silence.

Good Friday Celebration of the Lord's Passion: this is the only day of the year on which we do not celebrate eucharist (Mass). Although some people refer to Good Friday as the celebration of "Mass," our service is not a Mass. We listen to God's word, with special emphasis on the passion of Jesus, we offer special prayers for the universal church and the whole world, we venerate the cross and receive communion. We conclude this service, also, in reverent and complete silence.

Holy Saturday Easter Vigil: the church refers to this night as *"the holiest night of the year."* We pray to

Christ, *"the alpha and omega, the beginning and the end, Christ yesterday and today."* We light and bless our new Easter fire and our Easter candle. Catechumens celebrate their initiation into the church in the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and eucharist. This is the night of Christ's victory over death.

Easter Sunday: this is the morning of the resurrection. Churches will be, more than likely, filled to capacity. The music will be joyful, and we will be blessed with the new Easter water. This day, like the night before, is the celebration of Christ's victory over death.

Father Howard and I truly look forward to being with you for these celebrations of Holy Week. Please consult the front of this bulletin for our schedules for all 3 churches.
