Special Project: New Vestments for Mass
(Contributions Invited)

“Vestments” are the liturgical garments worn by the priest when celebrating Mass, and it has been several years since new ones were purchased for St. Anne and Assumption Churches. Typically, these are fairly expensive. Over the course of the past 10 years new vestments have been purchased once, and now it is time to look again at this need. Parishioners who might wish to contribute toward the purchase of new vestments are invited to do so by contacting the church office. An offering can be made in memory of a loved one and can be kept anonymous or mentioned by name once the vestments have been purchased.

We would like to purchase 4 vestments total (1 of each of the liturgical colors: white, green, purple, and red.) The vestments would be used at both churches (St. Anne and Assumption.) The estimated total cost is \$2,500. When Fr. Jamin has arrived, he and Fr. Trey will research and make the decision about which specific vestments to order. In the meantime, parishioners are invited to make a contribution toward this project by simply contacting the church office.

The Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
June 7th and 8th, 2008

Dear Friends:

As we announced last weekend, this present weekend (June 7th and 8th) will be Fr. Howard's last weekend with us. We had announced that he would take up his new assignment as associate pastor of Our Lady of Mercy Parish in Baton Rouge on Monday June 9th, but there has been a slight change in immediate plans. As you may recall, Fr. Clarence Waguespack (pastor of St. Joseph the Worker Parish in Pierre Part) has been experiencing a slower than expected recovery from back surgery. Given this, Fr. Howard will be substituting there on weekends for the month of June. He will be residing at the St. Philomena Rectory in Labadieville. This was pretty much unexpected. Please keep Fr. Howard in your prayers as he prepares to adjust to one parish and then again to yet another. This is not the ordinary way for a new assignment to begin, but sometimes we have to adapt when certain needs arise. As we pray for all of our priests who are moving this coming week, we continue to pray for Fr. Clarence and his recovery to good health.

I was able to attend Fr. Jamin's first Mass last Sunday at his home parish of St. Anne in Morganza. It was an awesome celebration! He is extremely excited about joining us here. I would ask that, as we welcome Fr. Jamin, we also give him the initial opportunity to move, unpack, and settle in. I need to be away this week. (This was scheduled prior to my knowing that Fr. Howard would be leaving and Fr. Jamin would be coming.) In light of this, and so as to give Fr. Jamin the chance to move in, we have cancelled all weekday Masses at all 3 of our churches. Fr. Jamin will be, however, on-call for emergencies. He is not yet available for appointments and general counseling, but if there is an emergency need, he will readily rise to the occasion! Just contact either of our church offices if such a need arises.

While we are always excited to welcome any new

priest, I cannot stress enough the need for all of us to allow Fr. Jamin some time to unpack all of his belongings and move into his room and office. I will also need to meet with him at length regarding various procedures, calendar items, and so on. Please pray for us as we begin the process and experience of working and ministering together.

This past Thursday our combined staffs of all 3 church parishes took Fr. Howard to lunch and spent some time with him. This was our chance to thank him (as a group) and to say farewell. While he will be helping out at St. Joseph the Worker for the month of June, his new mailing address is:
