Weekend of June 14th & 15th, 2008 Sunday of Ordinary Time



This weekend we welcome **Father Jamin David** to the churches of St. Anne, Assumption, and St. Philomena. Father Jamin is a native of Morganza and was a parishioner of St. Ann Church there. He is a graduate of Catholic High School of Pointe Coupee in New Roads. Growing up in the small, rural and heavily Catholic town, he experienced God's call to serve His people as a priest among the smiles and tears of the people with which he lived. He entered seminary immediately after high school at the age of seventeen. After attending college four years at St. Joseph Seminary College near Covington, he graduated and earned his B.A. in Liberal Arts and Philosophy, graduating *magna cum laude*. Fr. Jamin then entered Notre Dame Seminary and Graduate School of Theology in New Orleans where he earned his Master's degree in Theology, again graduating *magna cum laude*. At both seminaries, he served as Treasurer and Guest Master.

Fr. Jamin was ordained a transitional deacon on 9 June 2007 at St. Joseph Cathedral in Baton Rouge. He was assigned to serve the people of St. Mark in Gonzales under the pastorate of Very Rev. Joel LaBauve immediately thereafter. His pastoral and ministerial experience is varied as he participated in a gamut of different assignments during his seminary tenure. In addition to his home parish of St. Ann in Morganza and St. Mark in Gonzales, he also served the communities of St. Isidore in Baker, Immaculate Conception in Denham Springs, and Sacred Heart of Jesus in Baton Rouge.
