A Weekly Letter from Our Clergy

August 2nd and 3rd, 2008



Dear Friends:

Fr. Jamin on Vacation: As I write to you this week, Father Jamin is away enjoying a few days of vacation. This is the first time that he has taken any time off since his arrival here at the end of June. Please keep him in your prayers. I might take this opportunity to once again remind everyone of the correct pronunciation of his first name. I have, more than once, typed in the bulletin and in the announcements prior to Mass a phonetic description of how to pronounce it, but it seems that several people still get it wrong. So, please take note of the following: his first name is **Jamin** and is pronounced “**jay-men.**” Just like “**jay**” (as in Blue Jay) and “**men**” (as in the plural of “**man.**”) You might find yourself smiling or laughing as you read this, but I’m sure that you will agree with me that we all feel good when other people “get our name right.” So, at the risk of this sounding like an unnecessary request, if you are unsure of the pronunciation, please make note of it. Thank you very much.

St. Philomena Communion Procedure: St. Philomena parishioners are invited to read the article printed on the cover of this week’s St. Philomena bulletin regarding the upcoming (slight) change in the procedure for distribution of communion during weekend Masses. Over the past year we have discussed this possible change with our Liturgy Committee, and Father Jamin and myself have also discerned the need to move forward. I would invite everyone who might be affected by this change in procedure to make special note of it and, beginning on the weekend of August 9 and 10 to please help us with this new process. I realize that the current procedure has been in place for many years now,

but our new procedure will be the more appropriate way to offer communion. Please know that we will make special note of those seated in the front pews, so as to see to it that you receive communion first. Thank you again for your understanding and help with this aspect of our celebration of eucharist

Tri-Parish Listening Sessions: As a means to assist us as clergy (and our Parish Councils of Ministries) in discerning the needs of our communities, we will be sponsoring 4 Listening Sessions: 2 at St. Philomena and 2 at St. Anne and Assumption. Council of Ministries members, along with other parishioners-at-large have been invited to take part in these sessions. The focus of our conversation will be the following question: “*what do you feel are the most pressing needs facing our parishioners today?*” Each of the evenings will begin with prayer and a brief presentation regarding the life and recent histories of our communities, followed by small group discussions. Hopefully, through this process, we will then be able to better understand our needs and our call to serve and respond. I ask your prayers as we proceed in this experience. The sessions are scheduled for August 19 and 26 (for St. Philomena: to be held in Fr. Berthault Hall) and August 20 and 27 (for St. Anne and Assumption: to be held in the Msgr. Landsmann Center.) If you received an invitation to attend, I would ask that you help us out by giving us a call as soon as possible.
