Dear Friends:

This past Friday marked the *Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary*. This day holds a special place in our hearts, as it is our privilege to share in the life of the oldest church in Assumption Civil Parish. In considering this feast day and the history connected with it, I am also inclined to consider the future. It has been an honor for Father Jamin and I to serve as priests for St. Philomena, St. Anne, and Assumption Parishes. I know that I speak for our staff members also when I say that they consider this their privilege as well. In an attempt to be even more effective in our ministry together, and as a means to help Father Jamin, our Councils of Ministries and I better understand the needs of our communities, I would like to remind you that during this coming week we will begin holding our *Parish Listening Sessions*. As I have mentioned in our bulletins during the past couple of months, these Listening Sessions are designed to enable a dialogue among parishioners centered around the question, “*what do you see to be the most important needs of our faith community today?*” Council of Ministries members, church personnel, ministry representatives, and a few other parishioners selected at-large, along with Father Jamin and I will meet on 4 evenings to discuss this question. Last Thursday, August 8, we met all day with all of our church personnel and completed the same process. *The St. Philomena Listening Sessions* will take place on

August 19 and 26, and *the St. Anne and Assumption Listening Sessions* will take place on August 20 and 27. Participation in these sessions has been by invitation to a sampling of ministry representatives and other parishioners. Upon the completion of these 4 nights of dialogue, we will publish to the entire community the results of our conversations. The next step would then be to meet with our Councils of Ministries to set specific goals and begin the process of working toward them. As I have also mentioned in our bulletins before, parishioners should feel free to share their thoughts about parish life with any of our Councils of Ministries members. Please pray for God’s blessing upon our upcoming Listening Sessions, that they would bear fruit as the Lord wills.
