Dear Friends:

I am very happy to announce to you our offerings in adult education for the Spring of 2009! During the 2 months prior to Hurricane Gustav our communities participated in a total of 5 Listening Sessions. The first was with our combined staffs, and the other 4 were held at St. Philomena and St. Anne/Assumption. You may recall that the focus question was: “what in your perception are the most pressing needs facing our faith community today?” Of the 6 major areas of need that were identified, the need for more adult education was echoed over and over again. In response to this need, Father Jamin and I have developed a schedule of 6 classes to be offered between St. Anne, Assumption, and St. Philomena during the months of February, March, and April. 
The Nuts and Bolts of How the Church Operates

If you call the church office now, you will notice a change in how calls are received and processed. During office hours, an incoming call will be transferred as it usually would.
