Fifth Sunday of Lent

Dear Friends:

By the time you read this, more rain will have probably come and gone. These past few days, however, have been beautiful. Yesterday in the late afternoon (Monday March 23) I just felt like driving. I had the top down on my Jeep and just took off. The sun was starting to go down, and it was a remarkable thing to see—again. Truly, I will miss those end-of-the-day moments around here. In just a few months, I'm sure the sounds (of my new environment) will be much different. So, in the meantime I'm just letting it all soak in. I've always particularly enjoyed Springtime around here. Feel free to stop by at any time if you would like to celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation.

While I have been given my new assignment, as of the writing of this column I am still not able to announce it. The diocese will be announcing all of the summer assignments at the same time, hopefully

in about a week. Please keep all of us in your prayers. Father Jamin does not yet know whether he will be remaining here or moving on. Trust me, as soon as we can let you know, we will. Thank you for your prayers and concerns during this time of preparation for transition.

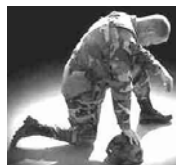
