A Weekly Note From Our Clergy

The Third Sunday of Easter
April 25-26, 2009



Dear Friends:

Lately the reality of moving on has been hitting Father Jamin and I pretty directly. It's hard to not look at certain annual events without saying, "wow, this is the last time I'll do this...or the last time I'll do that..." Such was the case with Holy Week and Easter. Thank you again for making that such a good experience for both of us. Although I will not be moving until the end of June, I have started packing and loading boxes and furniture into my P.O.D.S. unit. Father Jamin will be leaving much sooner. The weekend of May 16-17 will be his last weekend here with us. His first class at Catholic University in Washington, DC will be on June 1st. This is why we have printed on the cover of this bulletin a simple time-line showing what will be happening between now and the arrival of our new pastor for St. Anne and Assumption, Father Joel LaBauve. As of the writing of this bulletin column, a new pastor for St. Philomena has not yet been named. I anticipate that to happen shortly. When it does we will pass that announcement on to you.

Last week we celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Philomena with all of our students from all 3 of our parishes. I was so very proud of them. The church was packed. In fact, it was the biggest Confirmation crowd ever in my 12 years here. I would like to thank Kathy and Mable and all who work with them in sacramental preparation. Most of all, I want to thank our newly confirmed and their parents. Spending time with you in preparation for this sacrament was a real privilege for me. I wish you well and look forward to staying in touch with you long past my departure from here.

In closing this week I thought I'd share a little bit with you about my new parish, St. Jude the Apostle, in Baton Rouge. I received a copy of the annual *Spiritual and Pastoral Report* from the current pastor, Father David Allen. St. Jude has 2,300 families. (By comparison, St. Anne and Assumption

together have about 700, and St. Philomena has 1,100 registered families.) St. Jude also has a school, with more than 500 students in it, ranging from preschool through grade 8. I am really looking forward to spending time with not only the students but especially the faculty. I have always found that teachers, in both public and private schools, can teach us a lot. The church is located on the corner of Highland Road and Gardere Lane. According to Mapquest, that's 45.22 miles and an estimated 59 minutes from St. Anne Church. So, that's not even a hop, skip, and a jump. Coming back for visits will be easy, and I look forward to that greatly. Father Joel and I have spoken, and he is perfectly comfortable with me celebrating the weddings that I have scheduled here at this point. I will be returning for the ones where there is no scheduling conflict with weddings at St. Jude. I hope this doesn't bore you. Writing about it helps, I think, with the reality of leaving. Please keep me in your prayers, as you are in mine.
