# From The Tee Box

A Weekly Note From Our Clergy

June 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009

The Solemnity of the Most Holy  
Trinity



Dear Friends:

During Mass on Tuesday morning of this past week I mentioned that, every year at this time (when we return to the season known as Ordinary Time), I always think of Father Harry Thompson, SJ. Father Thompson was a Jesuit Father who passed from us not too many years ago. In his later years of life he served at Manresa House of Retreats but also continued to preach parish missions. He preached his first mission at St. Isidore Parish (in Baker) when I was serving there as associate pastor in 1988 and 1989. I think of Father Thompson, because he was known as an incredibly gifted preacher and his message was simple: finding the *extraordinary* in the *ordinary*. Jesus taught us a lot about how to find the grace and blessing of God's presence in the everyday, often difficult moments of life. He preached about the kingdom of God not only being realized and experienced (fully) in Heaven but about experiencing it (as fully as is humanly possible) in this life. Bill paying. Cooking supper. Washing clothes. Doing laundry. Changing diapers. Illness and infirmity. God is present to us in a unique way in the everyday things of life. Difficult moments, challenging moments, times when things do not go as we had expected or hoped—these are all opportunities for our faith to become deepened. Tuesday morning's prayer (from this past week) reads in part, "may we cherish the blessings that surround us." I think we would all agree that, in order to cherish the blessings, we have to first see them. Perhaps our prayer this week could simply be for God to grant us the vision necessary to see the *extraordinary* in the *ordinary*.

**(Father Jamin Update):** I spoke with Father Jamin on Monday of this past week. He called me just after he had finished his 2 classes for that day. He said that the temperature was in the 50's at night and the 70's during the day and that the weather was beautiful. He sends his greetings to all of you. I will
