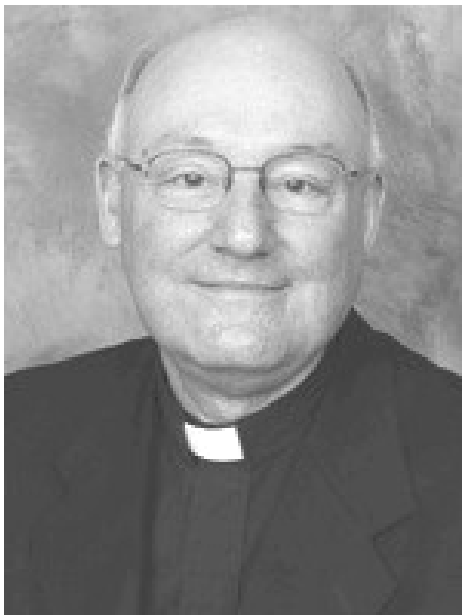

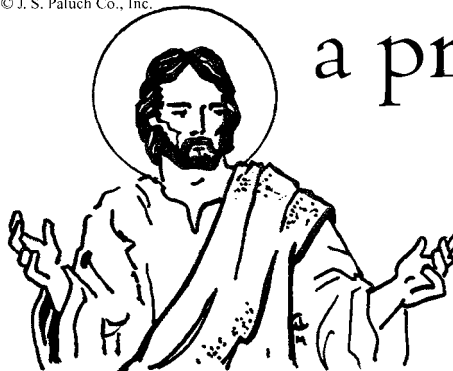
### **Baptisms & Seminars**
