COUNCIL OF MINISTRIES MEETING

Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption
Church Parishes,

The Assumption / St. Anne Council of Ministries met with me on July 14, 2009 and together we made some important decisions for our parishes. After sharing information and vision concerning the mission and work of the Council of Ministries, we took up a discussion of scheduling of weekday and Sunday Masses. We decided that we should not take any precipitous action regarding Sunday Masses due to my having just arrived in the parishes and that issue affecting so many people. We will continue that discussion as the Council members and I receive more feedback from parishioners concerning what will best serve the needs of our parishioners and allow the greatest number of people to participate in Sunday Mass in our parishes.

With the appointment of a pastor in Labadieville, it seems a good time to restructure our weekday Mass schedule. I am in the practice of taking Monday as my day off each week. Fr. Michael Alello, pastor of St. Philomena in Labadieville, prefers to take Friday as his day off. So we agreed each of us would have no scheduled Mass on our respective days off but that the other would schedule a weekday Mass on that day. With that in mind and seeking to create a situation in which the greatest possible number of parishioners might be able to participate in weekday Mass, the Council and I agreed upon the following weekly schedule for our parishes, with all Masses held at St. Anne Church:

Monday ----- No weekday Mass
Tuesday ----- 5:00 PM
Wednesday - 12:10 PM
Thursday ---- 5:00 PM
Friday ----- 7:00 AM

The time and place for Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses will remain the same for now.

The Council established a regular schedule of quarterly meetings (4 times per year) to undertake follow-up to the listening sessions held throughout the parishes during this past year and to develop

specific initiatives to respond to the parish needs surfaced during those sessions. I will keep you informed as that work proceeds.

I appreciate the sacrifices made by the members of the Council in service to the work of the Church in our community.

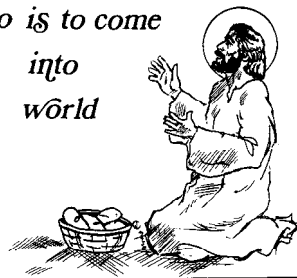
