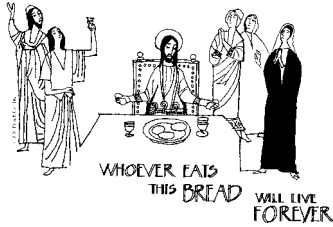

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS REGARDING PARISH BUDGETS

Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption Church Parishes,

I appreciate Bishop Muench taking the time to be with us at the Sunday Masses this weekend to officially install me as the Pastor of St. Anne and Assumption parishes. I already feel like a long time resident of these communities due to you warm and gracious welcome to me during my first month in your midst.

I wanted to let you know several important projects of maintenance and repair that are underway in the parishes, all of which were in the advances planning stages when I came in as Pastor.

1. We entered into an agreement with Naquin Mold and Mildew Removal for the removal of mold and mildew from the interior of Assumption Church and the repainting of the entire interior of the Church except the sanctuary area, which had already been redone after Hurricane Katrina. This project is expected to take about six weeks to complete and it will be necessary to discontinue use of the Church during that six week period due to scaffolding and moving around of pews. I will give you at least a two week notice when we will have to temporarily begin having the 9:30 AM Sunday Mass at St. Anne Church until we can re-occupy Assumption. Of course, we will be unable to have any funerals or weddings at Assumption during that time either. No weddings are currently scheduled there for the near future. The cost of this project is just under \$ 53,000, which the Finance Council and Parish Council of Ministries unanimously approved being shared 50-50 by St. Anne and Assumption parishes.
2. We authorized Cajun Improvements, Inc. to begin work on replacing a gutter and drain system on the front of St. Anne Church so as to obviate an overflow from the flat roof at

the entrance which has been causing us problems on one wall. This company will also replace several pieces of siding on one of the towers of the Church that I believe have been off since Hurricane Gustav and one piece of siding on the rectory. The company will also install awnings on the entrances of Immaculate Conception Chapel at Canal, replace some loosened siding on that chapel, and install a window that needed replacement. This project will cost in the neighborhood of \$ 6,000 to \$ 6,500, depending on the extent of the labor needed at Immaculate Conception to finish the repairs. St. Anne Capital Improvement Fund will pay the cost of repairs at St. Anne Church and rectory and Immaculate Conception Capital Improvement Fund will cover the cost of repairs at the chapel.

Your comments and questions on Church administration are always welcome.

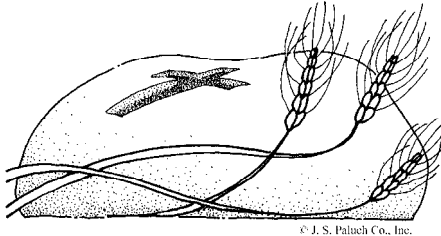
