Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption,

Please note the announcement on the front page of this bulletin concerning the temporary movement of the 9:30 AM Sunday Mass from Assumption Church to St. Anne Church, effective Sunday, September 6, 2009. This will allow for the removal of the mold and mildew from inside the Church and repainting of the entire congregational interior. I will let you know when we will be able to return to Assumption Church for this Mass each Sunday.

I am happy to announce that we have received donations to replace four of the twelve exterior lights at St. Anne Church. All twelve need replacement. The cost of replacing each is \$ 320. If you wish to join in our "Adopt a Light" program, please call Cheryl at the parish office (985-369-6656).

In regard to controversial issues in our country, sometimes the line between politics and social justice gets a little blurred. The issue of Health Care Reform is certainly a controversial one. In all the political rhetoric going on, the Catholic Bishops of the United States have asked us Catholics to keep in mind four basic principles which should guide any health care reform effort. I ask you to urgently consider keeping Congress informed of our desire as Catholics concerned about the well being of all in our country that these principles be carefully adhered to in whatever political solution is found to health care reform in this country. These are principles of social justice which may sometimes be endangered in this political controversy. They are:

- 1) Include health care coverage for all people from conception to natural death and continue the federal ban on funding for abortions.
- 2) Include access for all with a special concern for the poor.
- 3) Pursue the common good and preserve pluralism, including freedom of conscience.
- 4) Restrain costs and apply costs equitably among payers.

Let us all prayerfully consider these principles as we

exercise our right as citizens to voice our opinions on the various political means available toward their implementation.
