ISN'T THERE ALWAYS MORE?

Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption Church Parishes,

As the work of mildew removal and painting of the interior of Assumption Church continues, two new problems have cropped up which must be immediately addressed. It seems the damage caused by Hurricane Gustav at the roof line on the southeast corner of the church was more extensive than thought. With the big rains during the last couple of weeks, water was flowing down the inside of the wall of the Church at that point. It appears some bricks were damaged at the roof line and a crack developed at the point where the wall meets the roof. I am currently in communication with both a brick treatment company and a roofing company concerning costs for closing of that crack and installation of flashing, as well as replacement of gutters where the gutters have rotted, in order to do away with this entry of moisture into the Church.

Another situation of moisture entering the Church must also be addressed. The brick and mortar walls of Assumption Church apparently are in need of tucking and sealing. Records indicate that this was done to St. Anne Church around 2004. It is an essential process for older brick structures every 7-10 years. I witnessed a test of the walls for moisture seepage last week. A small test tube structure is sealed to the brick and filled with water. How quickly the water leaves the test tube into the brick indicates how much moisture is entering the Church through the bricks and the speed of absorbency by the bricks. Within 10 seconds, all the water had drained out of the test tube. Those conducting the test said they had never seen that rate of absorbency. With this much moisture going into the Church, the interior work we are currently doing will not last long. Thus this problem as well must be immediately addressed.

While I am getting estimates on this work, I will also get an estimate on caulking the windows on Assumption Church and scraping and painting the wood around the windows. You may have noticed that they are badly deteriorating and I am sure that is a source of moisture entry as well. As soon as I have these figures, I expect to call a special joint meeting of the Parish Council and Finance Council for our

parishes to decide how to accomplish these items of immediate need. Pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in this endeavor.
