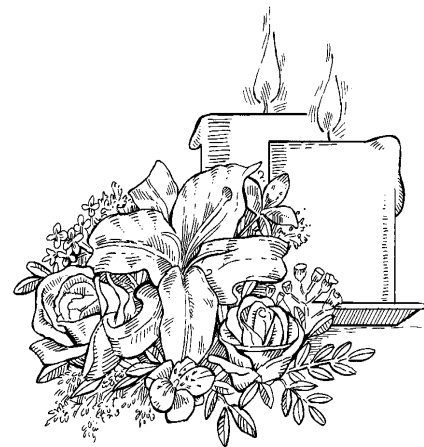

## **THE NEWS GETS BETTER!**

Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption Church Parishes,

I much prefer good news to bad news, don't you? Well, here's some good news. Our St. Anne Adopt a Light Program has brought in enough funds to change all the outdoor light bulbs and fixtures - yes, all twelve. Many thanks to the generous donors who offered memorial or other donations for the successful completion of this program. We have previously ordered four bulbs and fixtures and this past week, I ordered the final eight. Sometimes it takes a couple of months to receive them. We are in the process of preparing and repainting the poles so that when the lights come in, we can put them up.

Painting continues on the interior of Assumption Church. I have spoken to our insurance company about the possibility of funds to repair the hole in the wall near the roof on the southeast corner of the building. I believe it was caused by Hurricane Gustav and the company hired to repair the church building (Belfort, Inc.) may have overlooked this damage. Catholic Mutual Insurance is sending a contractor from Belfort by to assess the damage and assure whether or not they were paid for this work. He is supposed to be working in this area and will contact me soon. I will keep you informed.

I had a good meeting with all our homebound Eucharistic ministers recently and another good meeting with our St. Anne and Assumption Liturgy Committee. As regards the homebound ministers, I am asking that no parishioner bring communion outside of the church without letting me or Cheryl in our parishes' office know that they are doing so. I wish to visit the homebound of our parishes as well and need to keep my list updated as to who is receiving at home. Further, there are cases of several people bringing communion to the same person. We found that in some cases more than one minister is bringing communion to the same person without the ministers being aware of it. Also, it makes keeping track to be sure all who request it are receiving communion regularly. Finally, our Homebound Eucharistic ministers are commissioned only for the parishes of St. Anne and Assumption. They must have the permission and knowledge of the Pastor in any other parish to which communion is brought. This includes hospitals and nursing homes outside

our two parishes. I am so grateful to the men and women who carry out this generous and most needed ministry.

The Liturgy Committee graciously responded to my questions and gave me an arm's length list of items needed for Liturgy of which I need to be aware. I am compiling the list now and will attack each item one by one as funds allow.

I love being Pastor of St. Anne and Assumption parishes and Immaculate Conception chapel. I look forward to All Saints Day Mass at the latter.
