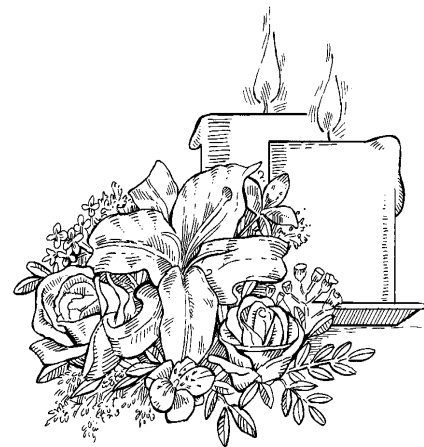

POT POURRI

Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption Church Parishes,

This coming week of October 12-15, 2009, all priests of the Diocese of Baton Rouge will be on retreat at Manresa Retreat House in Convent, LA. While I will be available to respond to life and death emergencies, I will not be present for weekday Masses on Tuesday or Wednesday of this week. Thus those Masses are cancelled. Any intentions taken for those Masses will be transferred to a later Mass I offer either at the nursing home or for the homebound, for which we do not accept stipend intentions. Please pray for us priests that this may be an experience of growth in holiness so that we might better serve well the People of God throughout our Diocese. Know that I will certainly be praying for you.

Allow me to give you an update on the work at Assumption Church. The interior painters are moving along well and appear to be at the present time on schedule to finish in the allotted six week period. Other work must be done to preserve the Church from absorbing moisture and I am currently getting quotes on that, including: 1) painting and sealing the window frames on the outside, 2) tuck and seal the bricks and mortar around the entire exterior of the Church to prevent absorption of moisture through the bricks, 3) replacement of rusted out and inadequate gutters all around the Church and missing flashing in several places, and 4) repair of the exterior bricks and interior plaster on the southeast corner of the church at the top of the wall through which water pours in during a hard rain. I have met with a gutter and flashing company and a company that can accomplish the other required work and they are preparing proposals for us. I will meet this week with a representative of the company that did repairs on the Church after Hurricane Gustav and am in contact with our insurance company concerning the possibility of filing an amended claim for any hurricane damage that was not repaired in the original repairs. As soon as I can collect all this information, I will call a special meeting of the Parish Council and Finance Commission to discuss and decide how we can best finance and get this work accomplished. It must be done. Your assistance through the monthly Building and Maintenance collections would be greatly appreciated.

Many thanks to Coordinator Doug Guillot and the volunteers who came this past Saturday (October 3) to assist with cleaning of the cemetery and church grounds at Assumption in preparation for All Saints day. Approximately 10 persons were on hand to accomplish a multitude of tasks. Remember that the work continues every Saturday in October. Whether you can come from 7 AM to noon or any portion of that time, please consider coming out to assist. I know we are all proud of all three beautiful Churches which make up our parish cluster and want to do everything we can to see them well preserved and maintained.
