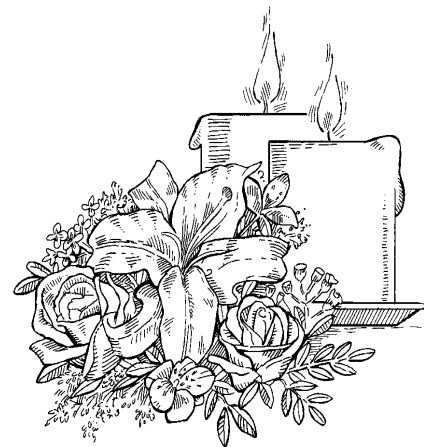

Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption Church Parishes,

I am really enjoying getting to know your faces and names as the weeks go on. Each week, at a meeting or a sacramental celebration of every kind, I put a few more names with a few more faces. Please continue to be patient with me in that regard.

The interior painting of Assumption Church is proceeding on schedule and I was informed last week we should be able to return to the Church with no difficulty by All Saints Day (Sunday, November 1) As of now, begin to plan to have 9:30 AM Mass at Assumption Church on that date, with the blessing of the cemetery to follow. As noted in last week's bulletin, the blessing of St. Anne Cemetery will be immediately following the 4 PM Vigil Mass on October 31. The blessing of the Immaculate Conception Cemetery on Canal Road will follow a 7 AM Mass at that chapel on November 1. There will be NO 8AM Mass at St. Anne on November 1. Please pass that word around to your family members who will be with us on that weekend.

A special joint meeting of the Parish Council and Finance Council will be held at the Landsmann Center at 7 PM on Thursday, October 22, 2009. The purpose is to discuss the exterior work that needs to be done on Assumption Church in order to seal out the moisture which cause the mold and mildew we are now removing. I have received proposals on the total work totaling \$ 109,341. If any parishioner wishes to attend that meeting, you are most welcome. If necessary because of attendance, we will move the meeting to the parish hall or Church. All ideas are welcome.

I am hearing from some of our dedicated older parishioners who have chaired ministries for some time that they really need younger parishioners to take over. If there is anyone who would be willing to chair the Bereavement Committee for Assumption Parish, I would like to hear from you. The work of this committee is to provide food for the families of those having funerals of loved ones at Assumption Church. A list of persons willing to provide that food is available.

I trust we are all continuing to grow in the spiritual life even as we care for the buildings and for the provision of ministries willed to us by those who have gone before. Without this spiritual growth, all the rest would truly be in vain.
