Dear fellow parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption,

Isn't it wonderful to feel some cool weather once again. It's been a long time since we enjoyed that experience. As Fall enters into our picture, so do we approach the end of the Church's year. Four Sundays from now, the season of Advent will begin. But first we celebrate next weekend the Feasts of All Saints and All Souls.

All Saints and All Souls Days have always had a special place in our Cajun culture. We hold our beloved dead in special remembrance as we celebrate these feasts. On All Saints Day, we celebrate the victory over sin and death of all who now share in the glory of the Risen Lord in heaven. On All Souls day, we remember in prayer any of our beloved dead who may await that share in Christ's glory in Purgatory for a time. Believing in the communion of saints, we believe our prayers and good works can assist our brothers and sisters in Purgatory on their journey toward the ultimate goal of heaven.

The communion of saints is a specific article of our Catholic faith. It recognizes the Church as having three dimensions, with all three united in a communion of life and prayer. The triumphant Church consists of the saints in heaven, the militant Church of the saints on earth who carry on the mission of Christ in the world, seeking to conquer that world with love, and the suffering Church consists of our brothers and sisters in purgatory. Their suffering consists of their longing for the fulfillment of their heavenly dream, which will in time come to pass. The triumphant Church (saints in heaven) assists the militant Church (us on earth) with their prayers and the militant Church assists the suffering Church (those in purgatory) with their prayers. Together, we all form one body in Jesus Christ.

Please remember the change in Mass schedule for next Sunday. The 4 PM Saturday Vigil Mass will be celebrated at St. Anne Church and the 9:30 AM Sunday Mass will be celebrated at Assumption Church, with the blessing of their respective cemeteries to follow each Mass. There will be no 8 AM Sunday Mass on All Saints Day. Instead, there will be a 7 AM Sunday Mass at Immaculate

Conception Chapel on Canal Road, followed by a blessing of the cemetery there. I look forward to being with you for those celebrations.
