Dear friends and fellow parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption parishes,

We welcome all who join our community from other churches and cities this All Saints weekend. You come surely out of respect for your family members buried in our cemeteries of Immaculate Conception, St. Anne and Assumption. You are always welcome here among us and we join you in prayer for our beloved deceased this weekend.

Many thanks to all who serve in the various ministries of St. Anne and Assumption parishes. Truly you are the life of our parishes. I do ask though that you reflect upon the importance of being present when assigned to these ministries. Since I arrived at St. Anne and Assumption, I have noticed a serious rate of absenteeism among assigned ministers, especially for liturgical ministries, and most especially among the altar servers. Thus I would ask our altar servers and your parents to begin taking careful note of your assigned Masses and being sure to either be present or call another server to take your place. We all need reminders once in awhile about taking seriously our commitments. I do as well. And, thank God, there's usually some good soul there to remind me!

At a joint meeting of our parish council of ministries and finance commission on October 22, unanimous approval was given by the membership and pastor to a plan to immediately proceed with the exterior work needed at Assumption Church for a total of something less than \$110,000. By the time you read this letter, I will already have approached the Diocese for permission to proceed with this project on an emergency basis. Without the work, considerable moisture will continue to seep into the beautifully repainted Church causing more mold and mildew problems. Our financial plan is to use \$55,000 in savings from Assumption accounts on deposit with the Diocese and to borrow \$ 55,000 at a rate of 3.5% apr for ten years from diocesan central financing. The Diocese generally requires 1/2 in up front cash to pay for capital improvement projects. Assumption's current operational surplus will allow the payout of this debt. However, since this will lower Assumption's savings below a desirable level, we will seek other sources for the funding of this project, including an appeal for special donations both from parishioners and friends outside of

Assumption parish, as well as any government grants or diocesan emergency funds that may be available. Since some of the damage appears to be related to damage from Hurricane Gustav, I will also be seeking a supplemental insurance allowance on this project.

Remember always to pray and trust that God will provide for us in all our needs.
