Dear fellow parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption,

Thanks are in order once again this week for volunteer work done for our parish families. Laboring at Assumption cemetery in preparation for All Saints Day were Doug Guillot, Rene Daze, Edward Guillot, Tom Simoneaux, Todd Crochet, Grant Crochet, George "Butch" Jumonville, Baron "Doogie" LeBrun, Donald Verrett, Brandon Verrett, and Daniel Guillot. They did a great job. Pressure washing of all the concrete around St. Anne Church was done by Roy Torres, Jr. and members of his family and co-workers. There was a great need for this service and it enhanced our celebration of All Saints Day as well. The Ladies Altar Society of Immaculate Conception Chapel did a good job of cleaning and setting up the chapel for our All Saints Day Mass. The beauty of the chapel, cemetery, and grounds and fellowship enjoyed by all over coffee and donuts after the ceremonies lent themselves well to a marvelous celebration.

Bishop Muench issued guidelines this week for the celebration of the Eucharist during this time of a swine flu epidemic in our country. He asks that those experiencing any flu symptoms know that they are excused from their Sunday obligation as long as symptoms last and that they not expose others to the possibility of spread of the disease. Persons should also feel free if they are concerned about catching the disease from exchanging handshakes during the sign of peace. A simple bow of the head will be just fine. Everyone should respect those who choose to give the sign of peace in this manner. Rules of good hygiene should always be followed. Eucharistic ministers will use an antibacterial hand washing aide before and after serving in that ministry at each Mass. These antibacterial hand washing aides will be available in the vesting sacristy at each church. The Bishop urges all to realize there is always a certain risk of germs that comes with any social event, including public worship. He recommends remembering, however, that in a time of history when things in life around us can seem so uncertain, we turn to God in public worship as the One who is certain, faithful, and present whenever we gather for the Eucharist and other public prayer.

Our parishes often employ contractors to do specific work. The duties of these contractors are outlined in writing before the work begins. Some are permanent

contractors (e.g.-grounds maintenance) and others are temporary (e.g.-major repair or construction projects). It is important that all communication with these contractors be done through the Pastor. Otherwise, they will receive conflicting instructions to which they cannot respond. I urge all our parishioners to take an interest in our churches and other parish facilities. But please bring all your concerns and even criticisms on such matters to me. I assure you I will listen and appropriately respond. That is my job, and I love doing it.
