Happy Thanksgiving to all! May you and your families enjoy a day of peaceful rest and great fellowship.

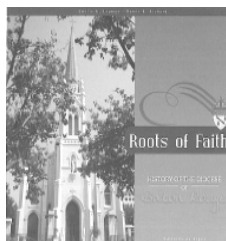
