Dear parishioners of St. Anne and Assumption Church Parishes,

We pause during this Holy Week to remember the climactic events leading up to the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Through them, our God has acted definitively to lead us, His people from the desert of sin to the oasis of new and eternal life.

The Mass of the Blessing of the Holy Oils takes place at St. Joseph Cathedral in Baton Rouge at 10:30 AM on Wednesday of this week. The priests of and/or serving in the Diocese of Baton Rouge will gather with Bishop Muench for this occasion and will together renew our vows of service to the people of this Diocesan Church. The oil of the sick (used in the sacrament of the anointing of the sick), the oil of the catechumens (used in the sacrament of baptism), and the Sacred Chrism oil (used in the sacraments of baptism confirmation and holy orders) will be blessed by the Bishop and distributed to all parishes of the Diocese for use in administering the sacraments throughout the next year.

On Holy Thursday at 7 PM, we will gather at St. Anne Church for the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper. During this ceremony, we will commemorate the institution of the sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Holy Orders by our Lord the night before he died.

On Good Friday, we will gather at Assumption Church at 3 PM to commemorate the death of the Lord, Jesus Christ. We will listen to John's account of Jesus' passion and death, venerate His holy cross, and receive Jesus' body and blood in the Eucharist consecrated the night before at the Mass of the Lord's Supper.

At 8 PM on Holy Saturday, the Easter Vigil Mass at St. Anne Church initiates our parishes' celebration of the Easter Feast. The lighting of the Easter candle and singing of the Easter Proclamation symbolizes the new light and life Jesus has brought into the world through his death and resurrection. Our joy has been brought to a climax. How great and wonderful is our God!

The celebration continues on Easter Sunday with an 8 AM Mass at St. Anne's and a 9:30 AM Mass at Assumption.

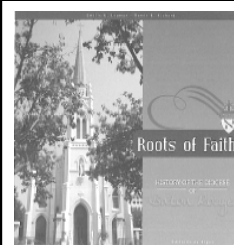
